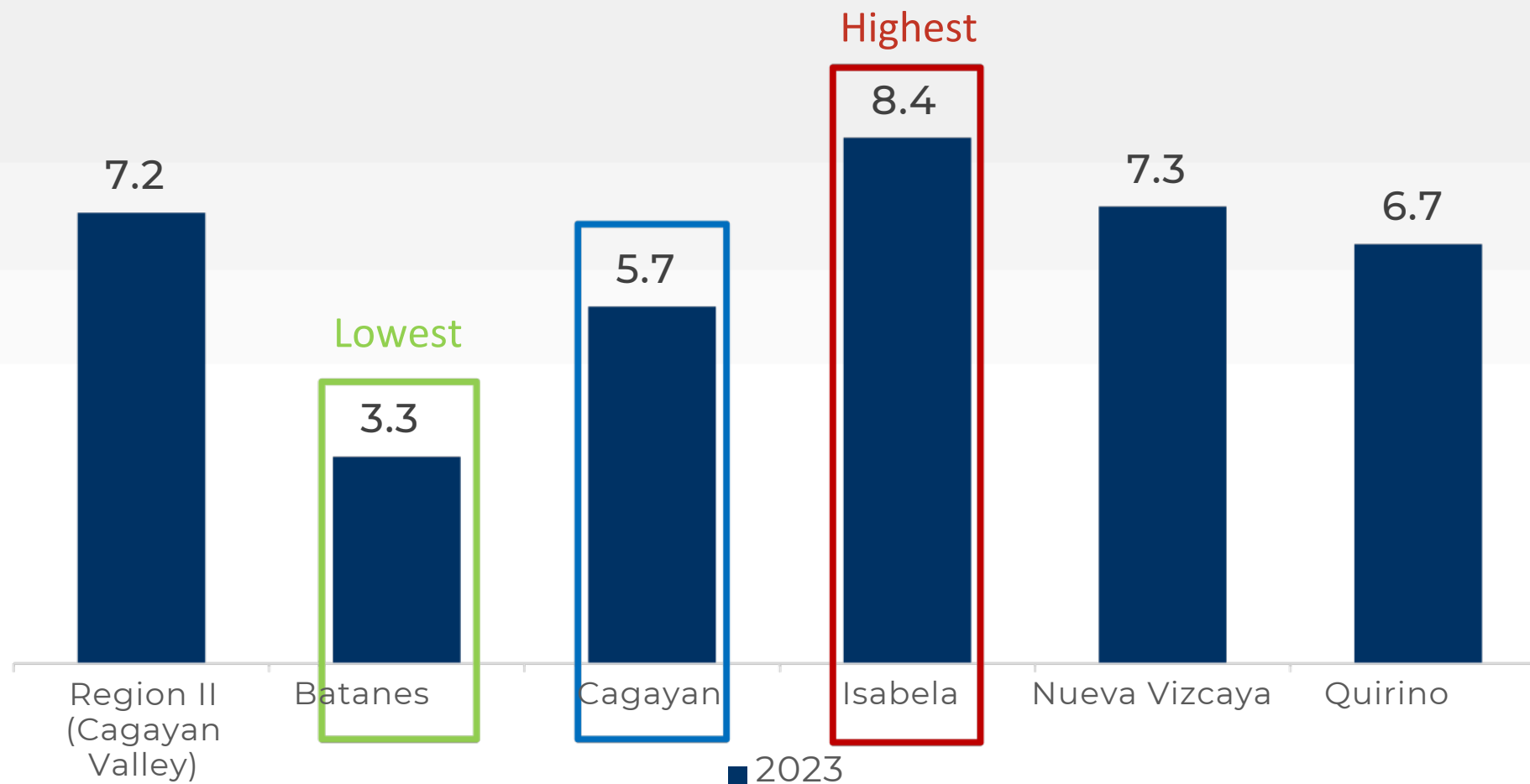

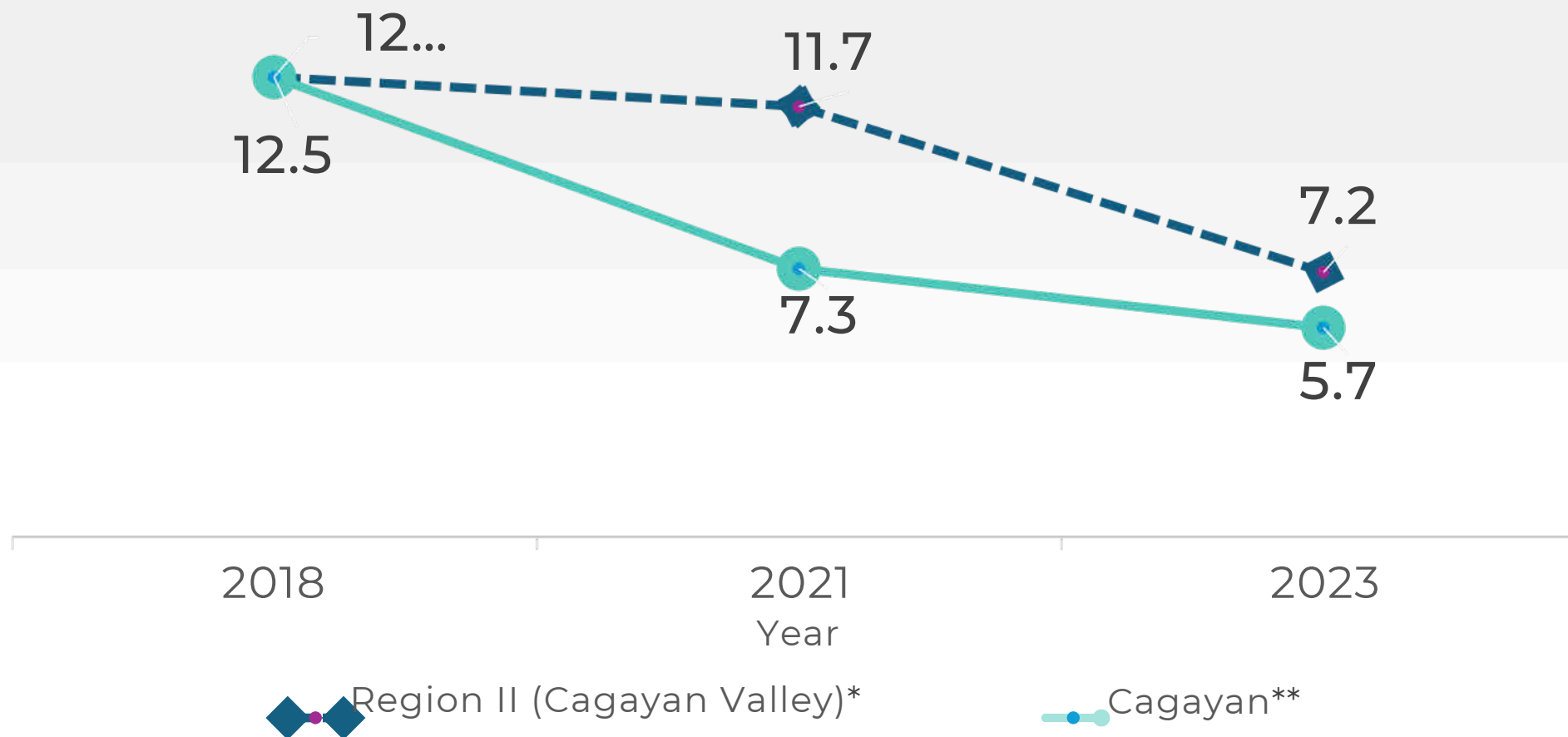

Full Year Poverty Incidence among Families, by Province: 2023 (in percent)



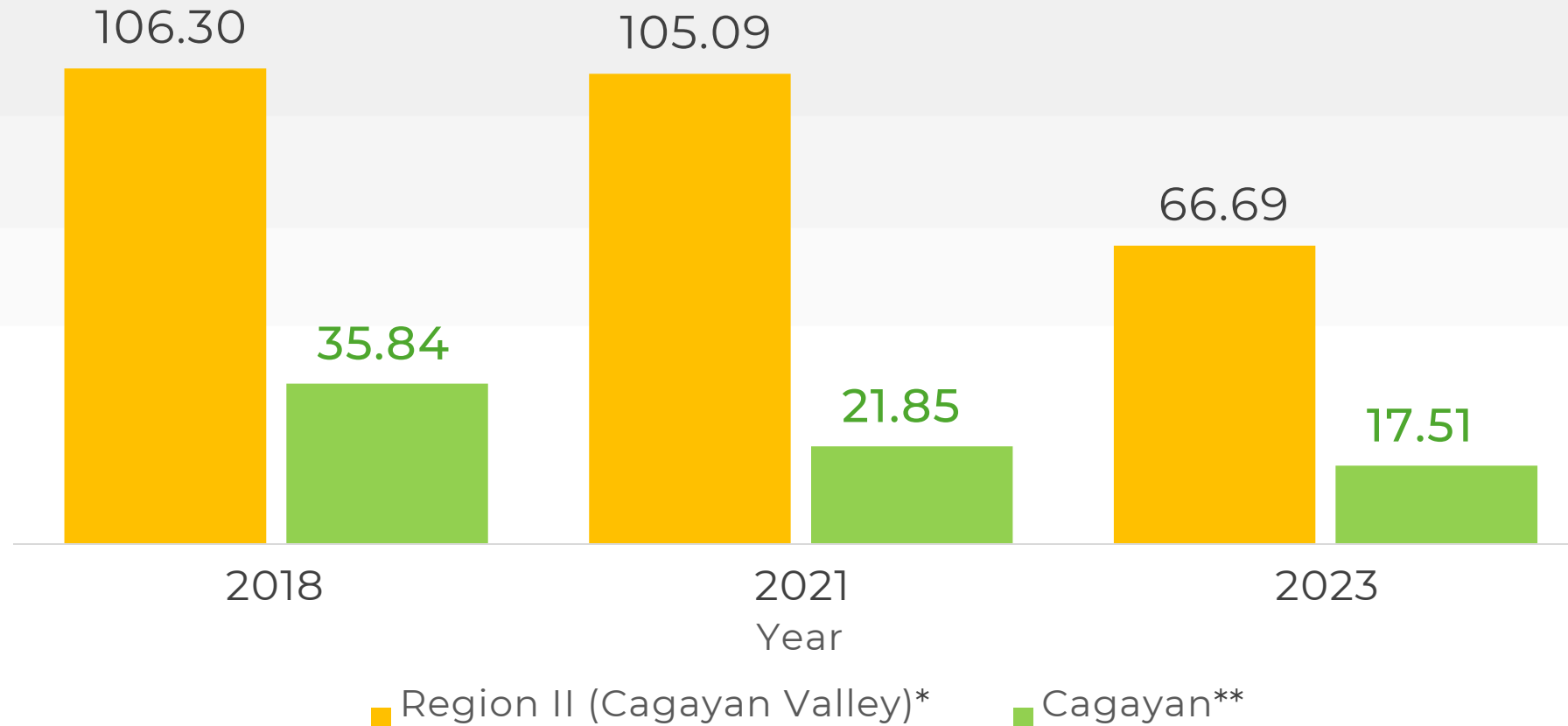
Full Year Poverty Incidence among Families, Region II (Cagayan Valley) and Cagayan: 2018, 2021, and 2023 (in percent)

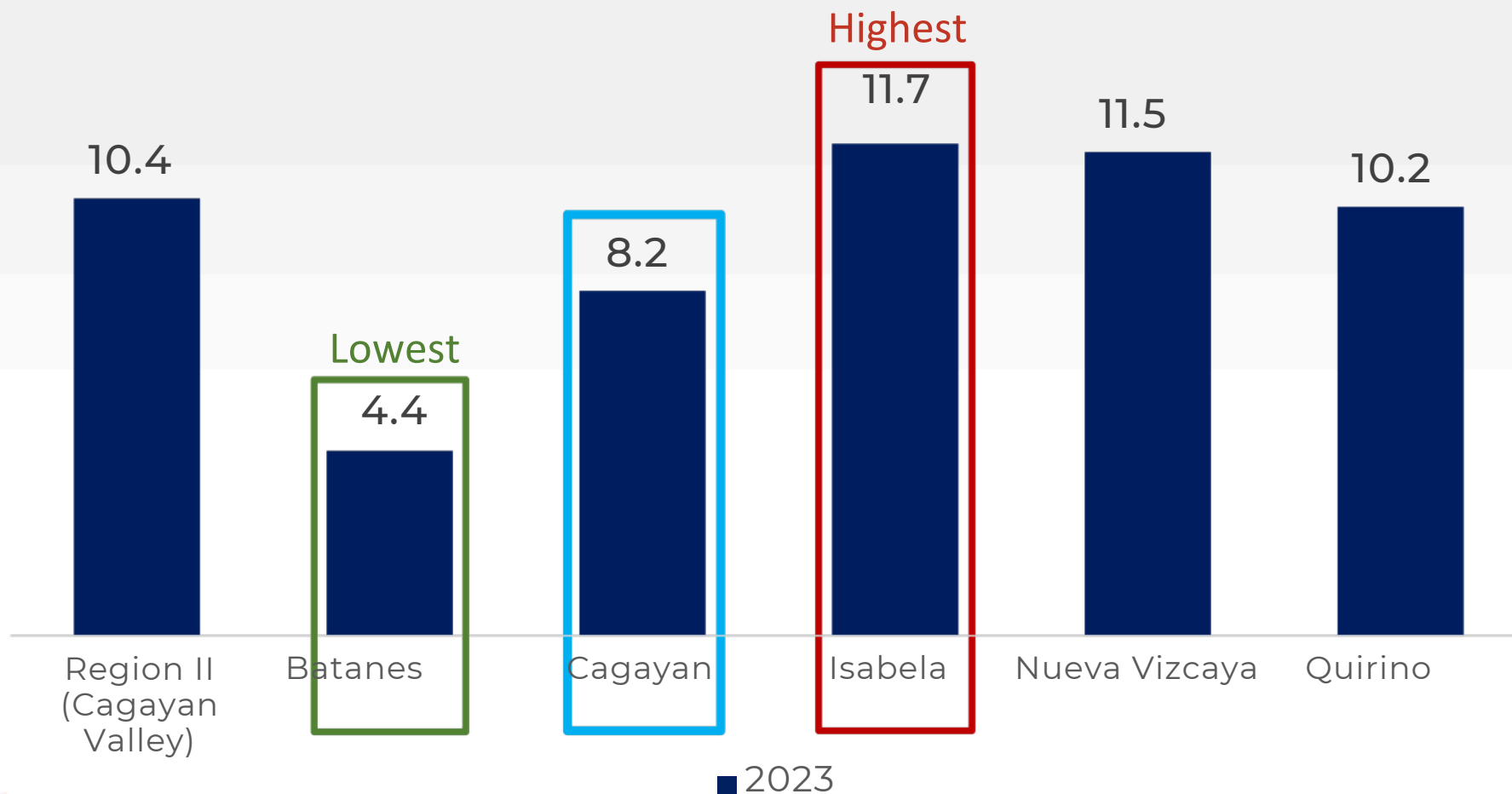
Full Year Magnitude of Poor Families, Region II (Cagayan Valley) and Cagayan: 2018, 2021, and 2023 (in thousands)



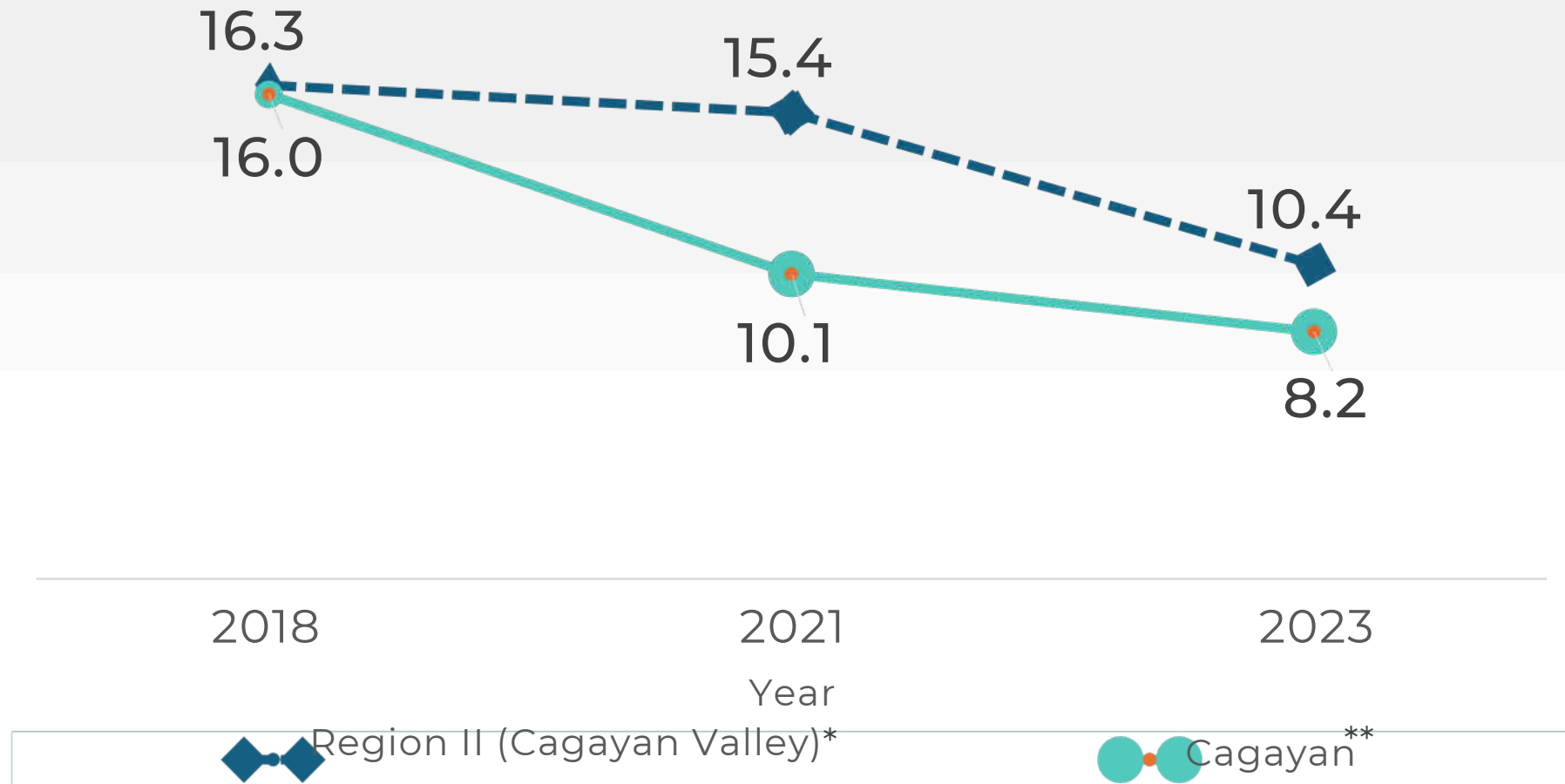

Full Year Poverty Incidence among Population, by Province: 2023 (in percent)



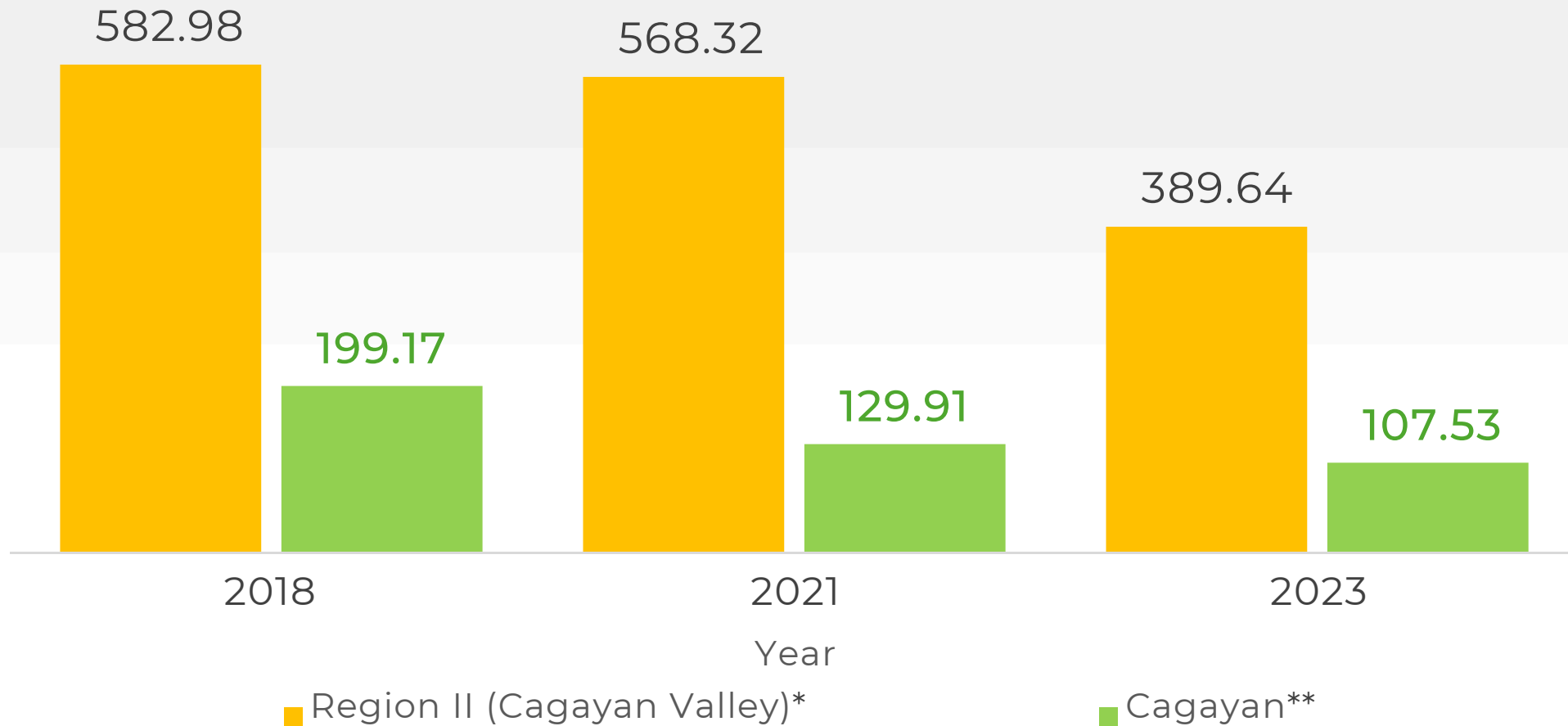
Full Year Poverty Incidence among Population, Region II (Cagayan Valley) and Cagayan : 2018, 2021, and 2023 (in percent)

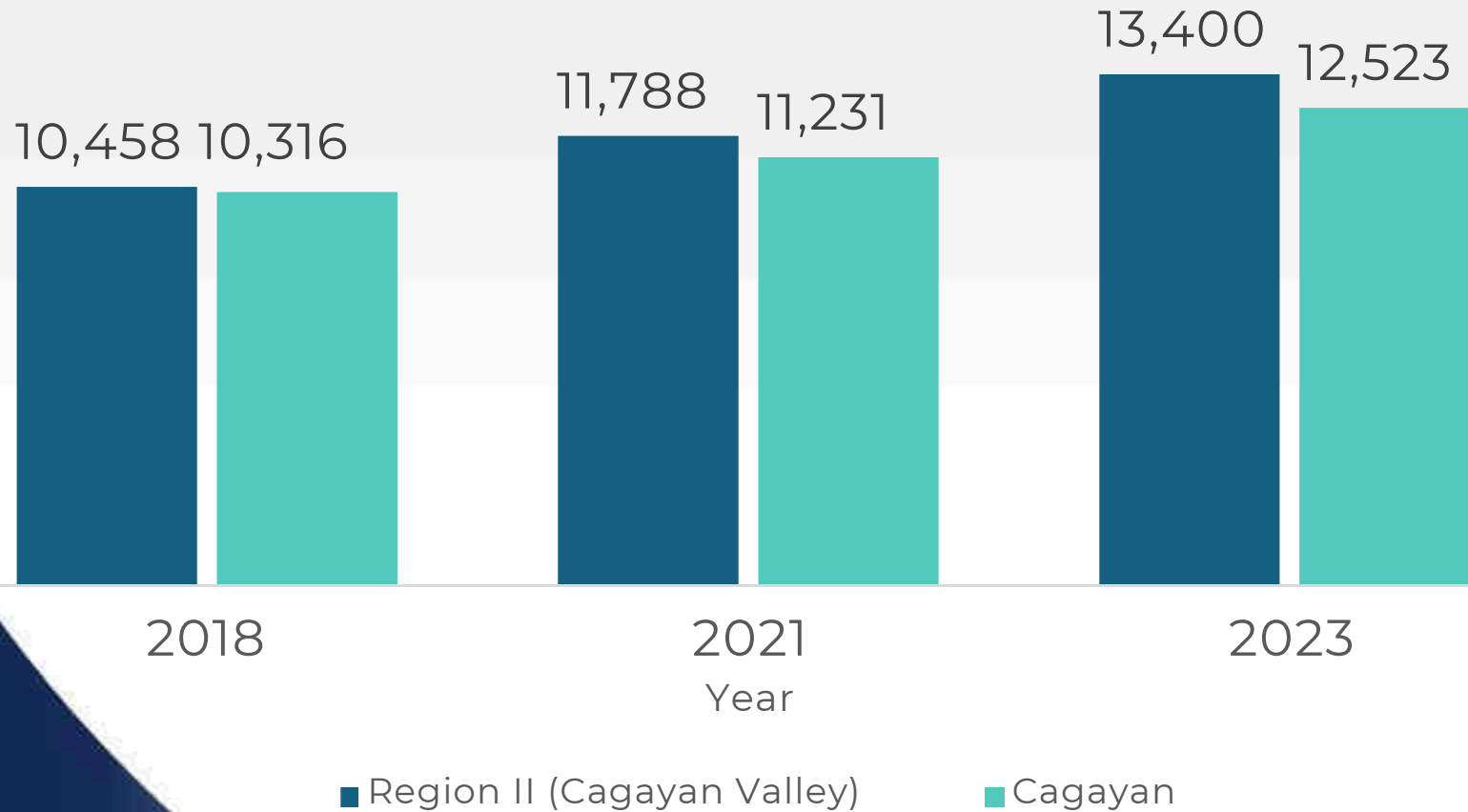

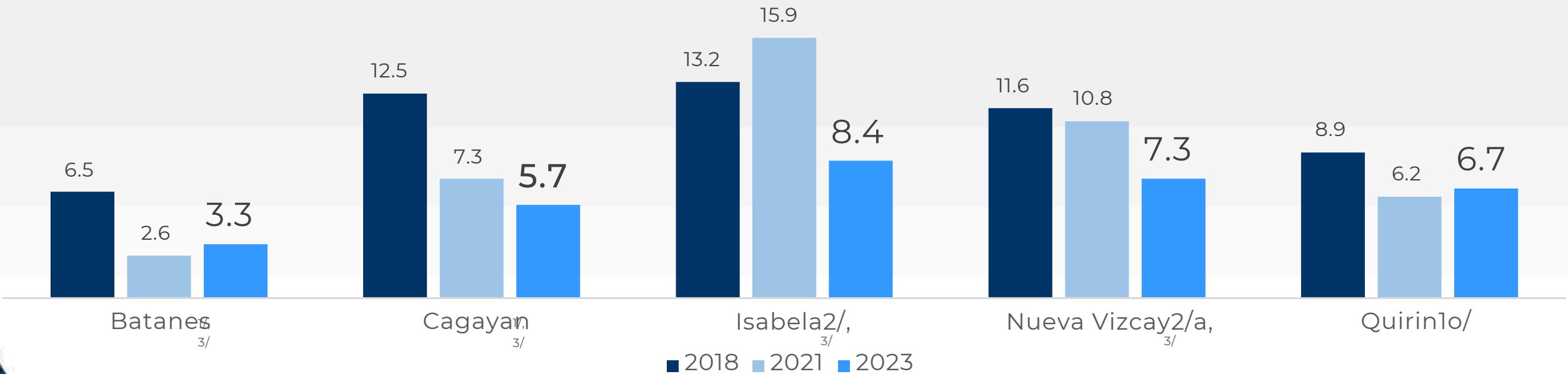

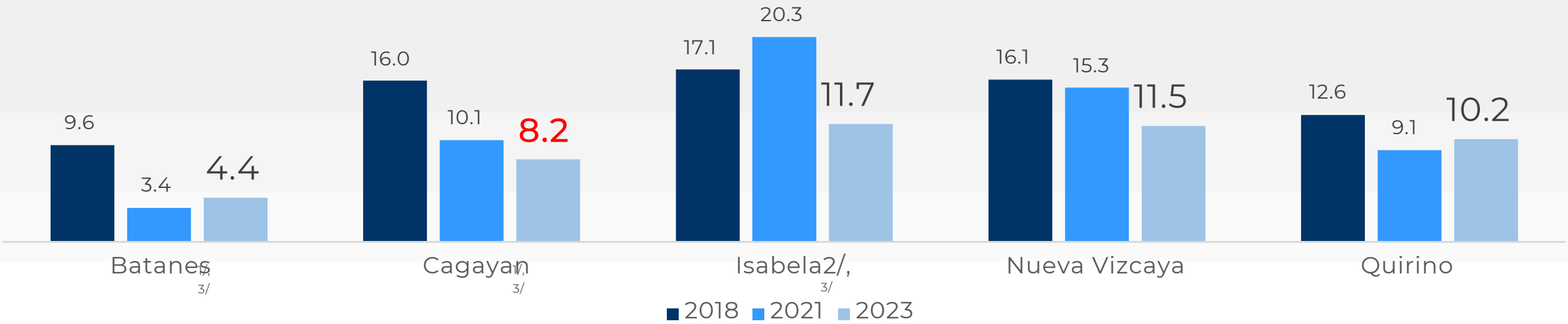

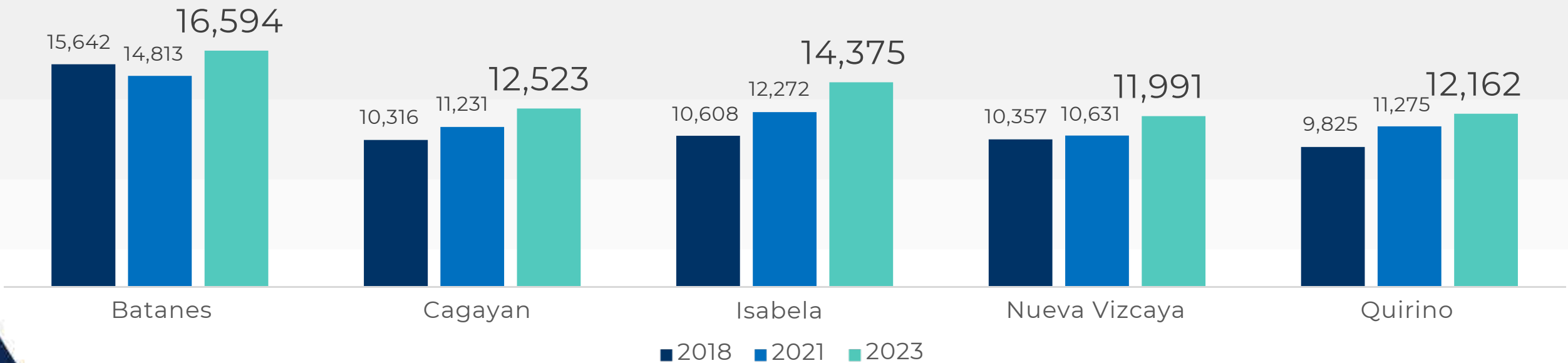
